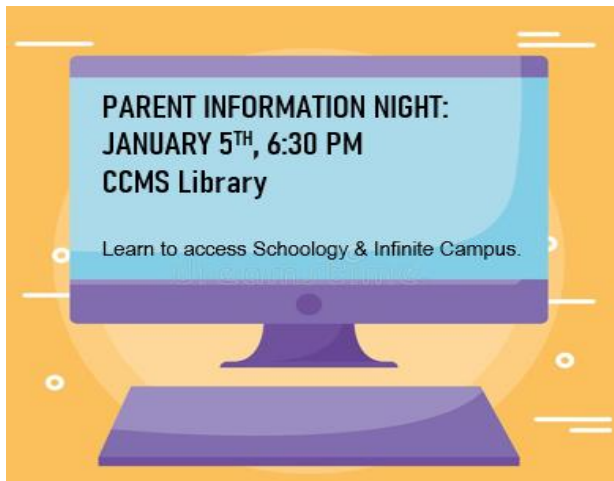


CCMS Update

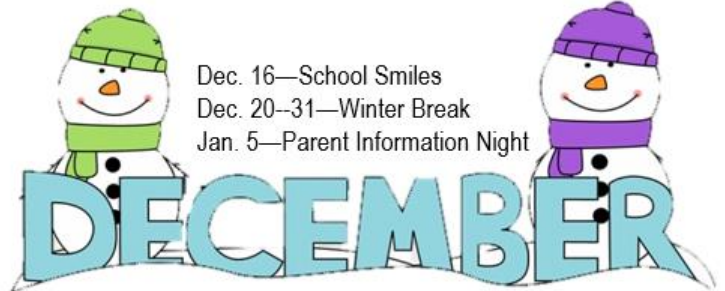

Build Your Community By Becoming a Learning Buddy



We are looking individuals 55+ who are playing an active role in a child's life for a new, paid, service opportunity

Northern Kentucky Community Action Commission's Learning Buddies Program, sponsored by AmeriCorps Seniors' Foster Grandparent Program, provides older adults who are playing an active role in a child's life the opportunity to build their support network through service opportunities and networking events.

Learning Buddies join children enrolled in local Head Start Centers for breakfast, lunch, or snack and/or help bring learning and support into homes by assembling care kits (if being in a classroom is not your cup of tea). They serve with another program participant whenever possible, so you will be making meaningful connections. Participants also take place in monthly community building events outside of the service station.

Schedules are flexible and will be made to suit your needs.

Benefits

Learning Buddies receive a tax free stipend (that does not impact benefit eligibility), mileage reimbursement, free meals on service days, and free bus passes on service days. You will also forge new relationships with people in your community and make a significant difference in the lives of others.

Eligibility

- Be age 55 years or older
- Be medically cleared to volunteer
- Pass state and federal background checks
- Commit to 1 school year of service - schedules are flexible and can be virtual

Apply

- Step 1 to joining is filling out a volunteer application.

- Once an application has been received, a phone interview will be scheduled.
